SUBJECT: Request for Approval to Enter into an Agreement with the Office of Hawaiian Affairs for the Repair and Maintenance of the Royal Mausoleum at Mauna`ala (Oahu)

The Royal Mausoleum at Mauna`ala, built for Hawaii's royal family, is under the management of the Division of State Parks. The Legislature, through Act 224, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006 (Act 224) appropriated ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$180,000.00) in public-land-trust funds for fiscal year 2006-07, for the repair and maintenance of the Royal Mausoleum at Mauna`ala, to be expended by the Office of Hawaiian affairs (OHA).

Act 224 stated that the sum appropriated shall not be taken from the public-land-trust proceeds designated for OHA pursuant to Section 10-13.5 HRS.

The Governor executed Executive Order No. 07-05 designating \$180,000 of the receipts from the use of public-land-trust land collected by DLNR for fiscal year 2006-07 and held in DLNR's ceded lands proceeds trust holding account as the \$180,000 provided for in Act 224.

Staff from DLNR and OHA has been working on this effort, as part of an overall project to make repairs and restore the Royal Mausoleum. The tasks identified for these funds are reconstruction of a rock wall, driveway repair, and replacement of a chain-link fence.
