Mr. Beatty is an Accessibility Specialist in the Access Board's Office of Technical and Information Services (OTIS). Since 1992, his primary duties are to provide training and other assistance to Federal, state, and local governments and private sector entities regarding the requirements of the Architectural Barriers Act (ABA) of 1968 and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990. Mr. Beatty participates in staff teams that develop and maintain accessibility guidelines under the ABA and ADA that form the basis of the enforceable ADA and ABA Accessibility Standards. Prior to joining OTIS, he served as a Compliance Specialist in the Access Board's Office of Compliance and Enforcement, where he investigated and resolved cases involving potential and identified violations of the ABA.

Earlene is part of the staff rulemaking team responsible for developing guidelines for medical diagnostic equipment.
